The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB Docket Nos. 22-104, 22-121, 22-124, and 22-125, recommending on the records certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent) that John Charles Allen, formerly of New Brunswick, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1995, and who has been suspended from the practice of law since July 6, 2021, be disbarred;

And respondent's brief in this matter having been due on December 19, 2022, and respondent not having filed a brief;

And good cause appearing;
It is ORDERED that John Charles Allen show cause before this Court on May 29, 2024, at a time to be determined by the Court, in the Supreme Court courtroom, Hughes Justice Complex, Trenton, why respondent should
not be disbarred or otherwise disciplined; and it is further
ORDERED that the Director of the Office of Attorney Ethics, or the Director's designee, present this matter to the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that no further briefs shall be accepted; and it is further
ORDERED that the schedule set forth in this Order to Show Cause is peremptory and no further extensions will be granted; and it is further

ORDERED that the respondent's suspension from practice pursuant to the orders of this Court shall continue pending further order of the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall continue to be restrained and enjoined from practicing law during the period of respondent's suspension and shall continue to comply with Rule 1:20-20 dealing with suspended attorneys.
