The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 19-035, recommending as a matter of reciprocal disability pursuant to Rule 1:20-14(a) that Mariama Odessa Ogilvie of Fort Washington, Maryland, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2006, be transferred to disability inactive status pursuant to Rule 1:20-12 based on respondent's transfer by the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania to a status equivalent to disability inactive in that State, effective May 24, 2010;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Mariama Odessa Ogilvie** is hereby transferred to disability inactive status, effective immediately, and until further order of the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent is hereby restrained from practicing law during the period that respondent remains on disability inactive status; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent comply with <u>Rule</u> 1:20-20 governing incapacitated attorneys; and it is further

ORDERED that all funds, if any, currently existing or hereinafter deposited in any New Jersey financial institution maintained by **Mariama**Odessa Ogilvie pursuant to Rule 1:21-6 shall be transferred by the financial institution to the Clerk of the Superior Court, who shall deposit said funds into the Superior Court Trust Fund, where they shall remain restrained from disbursement pending the further order of the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State.
