The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB-23-092, recommending that **Christopher M. Supsie** of **Forked River**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1994, should be admonished for violating RPC 1.7(a)(1) (engaging in a concurrent conflict of interest where the representation of one client will be directly adverse to another client), and RPC 1.7(a)(2) (engaging in a concurrent conflict of interest where there is a significant risk that the representation of one client will be materially limited by the lawyer's responsibilities to another client or by a personal interest of the lawyer) (three instances);

And the Court having determined to dismiss the matter;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that the formal ethics complaint against **Christopher**

M. Supsie in District Docket No. IIIA-2020-0010E is hereby dismissed.
