And the Office of Attorney Ethics having reported to the Court in a detailed certification that respondent has failed to comply with the Court's order;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Zaniah D. Maynor** is temporarily suspended from

the practice of law, effective immediately and until further order of the Court;

and it is further

ORDERED that respondent be restrained and enjoined from practicing

law during the period of respondent's suspension; and it is further

ORDRED that all funds, if any, currently existing or hereinafter

deposited in any New Jersey financial institution maintained by Zaniah D.

**Maynor** pursuant to <u>Rule</u> 1:21-6 shall be restrained from disbursement except

on application to this Court for good cause shown, pending further order of the

Court; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent comply with Rule 1:20-20 dealing with

suspended attorneys; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent

part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State.
